The current statement is “Inspire, Challenge and Support” and new one is “Challenging students trying to meet each individual student's needs.” Sean mentioned the statement needs to be open ended because we don’t know what each student really wants to do. Sean discussed what the School Improvement Data Summary will consist of which is: Student performance - classes students are enrolled in, extracurricular activities, Student engagement, Student Behavior - attendance and referrals.

	<p>Teachers will look at this data to help make professional goals and site Council will look at the SIP to see if a teacher's request for Profession Development will be approved. Sean is working with the ESD and the data system ARGOS to create data sets. Students who complete Algebra in 8th grade with an A are more likely to complete College. Students that take CTE courses have a higher attendance rate. Students that participate in Athletics have a higher GPA. We want to see if students that participate in CTE related clubs (HOSA, FBLA, FFA) are more likely to be tracking towards College. Student Clubs have been taking minutes and attendance, and that data will be used to track students. By 2025 students will be required to earn 9 college credits. We will be tracking sub-populations to see what can be done to increase their readiness. Students will be tracked by Cohort starting in 2016. In summary looking at the SIP, what questions are there, does anything need to be taken off or added to be able to make decisions regarding Professional Development? Sean will bring a condensed version of what the Strategic Committee is working on to the next meeting.</p>
